Description:

The 250 GT/E was manufactured by Ferrari from 1960 to 1963. It belongs to the wide-ranging model family of the Ferrari 250 GT, with which it shares essential elements of drive technology and chassis. The 250 GTE 2+2 was Ferrari's first produced four-seater and, with a production of 950 units, the most successful single model of the brand up to that time.

The current owner acquired the vehicle presented here in a very good original condition in Italy a few years ago. He then had the car **extensively partially restored** by a specialist in Germany. Among other things, the **engine was completely overhauled**, the **paintwork was renewed on bare metal** and the **original leather** upholstery was carefully reworked. The work is **documented by invoices for approx. 230.000,- €.** The vehicle was **certified by Ferrari Classiche**.

The timeless Pininfarina styling with the Grand Tourer practicality of the 250 GTE 2+2 makes this Ferrari with its outstanding driving characteristics a versatile, reliable touring car.
