Description:

The 'original model' of the W111 series was introduced in 1961. In 1969, the model with the 2.8-litre engine was launched on the market as a 'flat radiator version' with a slightly different appearance. This model was also offered with the completely newly developed 3.5 litre V8 engine on request and at extra cost. Only **3,270 units** were produced. These models were the last largely hand-built Mercedes, which is why the price of the coupés is almost twice as high as that of the saloons.

According to the available documents, the current owner acquired the vehicle around 20 years ago with a mileage of 88,782 kilometres. **Regular maintenance** has been documented and a **meticulous logbook** has been kept. The car presents itself in a **very well-preserved original condition**. According to the available data card, the current colour scheme in silver-grey metallic corresponds to the delivery. According to the available photo documentation, the **underbody was ice-blasted and then preserved**. The **interior is still original** and in very good condition. The total mileage is now **only 149,607 km**. A rare opportunity to acquire a 3.5-litre SE Coupé in this **sensational condition** at a very **interesting purchase price**.
