History and production:

Mercedes-Benz presented the W113 at the Geneva Motor Show in March 1963 as the successor to two models: The 300 SL and the 190 SL were replaced by the roadster - known as the 'Pagoda' because of its hardtop roof shape. The W113 was the first SL with a **safety body**. The floor assembly, axles and steering were largely adopted from the W111 S-Class of the time.

From 1963 to 1971, **48,912 units were produced**.

About this car:

This 280 SL has been **fully restored**. In the course of the restoration, the manual gearbox was replaced by a **five-speed manual gearbox**. The colour scheme and engine correspond to the delivery ('matching number'). The car has a **condition like new**.

This Pagoda is a special opportunity to acquire a very elaborately restored vehicle with a **five-speed manual gearbox** and hardtop in a very attractive colour combination.
