Description:

This Alfa Romeo 2600 Spider combines Italian car design of the 1960s with sporty driving performance. With its **powerful 2.6-litre six-cylinder engine** and a 5-speed manual gearbox, this convertible was the absolute **top model** from Alfa Romeo.

According to **confirmation from the Alfa Romeo archives**, the Spider offered here with bodywork from Touring was **delivered to Kuwait on 1 April 1963**. The car later came to South Africa before being sold to Germany a few years ago. According to the **available photo documentation**, the Spider was **extensively restored** a few years ago. The car was stripped down to the bare bodyshell and then **reworked in all assemblies**. Among other things, the vehicle was **converted to Weber carburetors**. The car impresses with its elaborate and **well-documented restoration**.

A good opportunity to acquire this beautiful Italian classic in an **attractive touring design combined with a powerful 6-cylinder engine!**
