## Description:

The Mercedes-Benz 300 SL Roadster was introduced in 1957 as the open-top successor to the legendary 300 SL Gullwing. Between 1957 and 1963, only 1,858 units were produced, with **approximately 270** of these later models factory-equipped with modern **disc brakes**. Today, the 300 SL Roadster is regarded as one of the most coveted and valuable classics in automotive history.

## About this vehicle:

The example presented here is one of only 270 Mercedes-Benz 300 SL Roadsters delivered with **factory-installed disc brakes**. It stands out not only for its exceptional overall condition but also for its **thoroughly documented history**. First delivered on February 23, 1962, through Mercedes-Benz Paris, the car's continuous and **traceable ownership history continues** in Germany from 1976 to the present day. All previous registration documents are available in their original form. These are complemented by a comprehensive collection of workshop invoices and correspondence, offering an impressive record of the car's provenance over several decades.

The vehicle impresses with its **high level of authenticity** – the engine still bears the factory-stamped number from its original delivery. In sum, this 300 SL Roadster is a car that captivates both technically and aesthetically, and stands out in particular for its originality and fully documented history – a **true collector's item with verifiable provenance**.
