Description:

The Maserati 3500 GT was the brand's first series-produced road car, marking a pivotal moment in the manufacturer's history. Designed by Touring, this elegant coupé impresses with its harmonious proportions and timeless lines. It is powered by a robust inline-six engine with triple carburetors, offering smooth and confident performance. The luxurious interior, combined with refined driving characteristics, made the 3500 GT one of the most desirable Grand Tourers of the 1960s.

About the car:

This Maserati 3500 GT Touring Coupé was delivered new in 1961 and is presented in excellently restored condition. The **elaborate frame-off restoration** was carried out with great attention to detail and is **extensively documented**.
