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Basis for this car was a Ferrari Testarossa Monospeccio with central-locking wheels - one of only 3 cars of this type that were handed over to the designer. The Italy-Swiss based Designer Franco Sbarro has designed and built this radical Sports-Roadster on the shortened chassis of a Testarossa together with the students of his Sbarro-Center and introduced the Alcador called Roadster on his display at the International Carshow in Geneva in 1995 (Genfer Automobilsalon). This is the original car from the 1995 display and the Alcador is-besides 2 outside mirrors that were added later- still completely original and did only 4.150 km since 1995.

This Ferrari Alcador has a legal German road registration ! Tested also by Jeremy Clarkson (Top Gear) - see Video...
