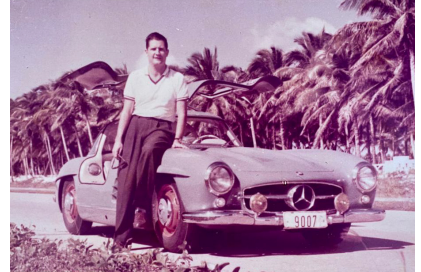

Model History:

Mercedes-Benz presented the 300 SL in February 1954 at the International Motor Sports Show in New York. It was the fastest sports car of its time. The Mercedes-Benz 300 SL "Gullwing" is regarded worldwide as a design and technical icon of the post-war era and remains one of the most prestigious models among automobile collectors. Between 1954 and 1957, **only 1,400 units** were produced.

About the car:

The vehicle offered here was originally delivered in 1957 to **Ramfis Leónidas Trujillo** in the Dominican Republic. He was a racing driver, playboy, politician, and son of the then Dominican dictator Rafael Trujillo. In 2009, the 300 SL returned from the USA to Germany, where it underwent **an extensive, well-documented full restoration** by renowned brand specialists, including photos and invoices. The subsequent ownership history is well known.

The 300 SL impresses with its **exceptionally high originality and unique colour scheme**. According to the available data card, the engine, transmission, rear axle, steering, differential, and front axle correspond to the **original delivery specifications**. **A unique opportunity to acquire a vehicle with exceptional provenance, first-class restoration, and impeccable authenticity.**
