Description:

The Porsche 911 T 2.4 from model year 1972 is part of a special transitional series within the classic F-model range — recognizable by the distinctive external oil filler flap on the right rear fender. This feature was only fitted in the 1972 model year, making this car a highly sought-after rarity among collectors.

Technically, the 911 T was powered by the long-stroke 2.4-liter engine with 130 hp, offering strong performance for its time and still providing a dynamic, purist driving experience today.

This particular vehicle impresses with its especially **attractive Platinum Metallic color paired with black leather** upholstery. According to the Porsche delivery confirmation, the car was originally delivered to **Culver City, California in 1972 and imported to Germany in 2004.**

The vehicle **history is fully documented**, including all relevant service and maintenance work. Over the years, **engine and gearbox have been professionally overhauled**, along with other technical work carried out to preserve and optimize the car. The mileage is fully traceable.

A rare opportunity to acquire a well-preserved example of the legendary “Ölklappe” model.
