Description:

At the 1966 Paris Motor Show, Maserati presented the Mexico as a four-seater GT coupé in the luxury class. The Mexico was based on a Bertone prototype from 1965. The production version was bodied by Vignale based on a design by Michelotti.

The first series of the Mexico was powered by a 4.7-litre V8 with four Weber carburettors, producing 290 HP. From 1969 the 4.2-litre V8 from the Maserati Quattroporte with 260 HP was optionally available.

In 1967 this very original Maserati Mexico was delivered to its first owner in Brescia, Italy. In the 80s, the vehicle was based in the USA. The car has an excellent original coachwork and is regularly technically maintained by the brand specialist Fa. Steinke in Hamburg.
